The Membership Chair's goal, to be accomplished with the help of their "Proposer" and "Seconder," is to ensure New Members are aware of our purpose, has experience volunteering on our community projects, participates in Club activities, and feels as if they are a welcomed and valued member of our Club.



New Membership Application Process

- 1. Meet with a Club member and/or Membership Chair to learn more about Club membership and the New Member Orientation Program.
- Attend a monthly membership meeting, help with a community project, and/or go on a field trip.
- 3. Identify a "Proposer and a Seconder" who will recommend your application to join the club.
- 4. Complete the Stonington Garden Club Application Form and send to your Proposer with a check for the application fee (\$75, payable to Stonington Garden Club). Your Proposer will submit your application, their recommendation letters, and fee payment to the Membership Chair. Deadline for application is November 1st or April 1st.

Once the application process is completed the Membership Chair will ask the club's Active Members to approve the applicant's "New Member" status in the Club. Upon approval the New Member will start the one-year New Member Orientation Program and pay annual dues (\$175).

New Member Orientation Program Overview

The New Member Orientation Program (Program) is designed to help New Members understand the purpose of our Club, learn how the Club operates, and meet fellow members. If at the end of the one-year Program the New Member is still interested in joining the club and they have fulfilled the Program requirements they will be 'voted' into the club as a "Active" Member.

Below are some of the expectations of New Members:

- I. Keep track of their participation in the Club's activities.
- 2. Attend as many of the Club's monthly membership meetings as possible. Meetings are (usually) scheduled on the second Wednesday of the month, 10am-12pm, at the La Grua Center in Stonington Borough, September June.
- 3. Participate in the Club's scheduled committee events, community projects, and volunteering in the Club's community gardens (i.e., Borough Post Office Garden, Wayland's Wharf Rain Garden, Lighthouse Museum Garden, COMO Children's Learning Garden).
- 4. Volunteer during our major fundraiser "Gardens by the Sea Tour." The next garden tour is June 12-13, 2026. All members are expected to purchase one ticket to the tour.

After completing the Program, the Membership Chair will ask the Active Members to approve the New Member to become "Active." If circumstances prevent a New Member from completing the Program, they will be invited to extend their New Member status for up to 24 months. New Members may not vote until they become Active. Once a New Member becomes an "Active" they are expected to take on a leadership role (e.g., Board Officer, Committee Chair, Project Lead, Administrative Role) to foster member relationships and support the Club's purpose.
