The garden club's history with the environmental sciences department at Stonington High School has included providing funds for materials needed for their outdoor gardens. In 2017, determined to encourage local students, the club established a scholarship award for a graduating senior, and now it sponsors an Environmental Studies Award (\$1,000) and an Environmental Awareness Award (\$1,000).
